

Guidelines for Using the Picnic Shelter at Outlot A

The following list of guidelines will need to be followed when a homemaker wishes to use the shelter at Outlot A.

- The homeowner (lot owner) must be in good standing with LAHA and have a key to open the gate.
- 2. A reservation date must be made with the LAHA President.
- 3. Any homeowner (lot owner) using the facility must take responsibility for setting up and cleaning up of the area that is used.
- 4. All garbage must be removed from the outlot at the end of the activity.
- 5. The following by-laws must be adhered to when using the shelter:
 - a. No vehicles can be parked in the outlot.
 - b. Alcohol is prohibited in the area as posted.
 - c. Use of the out lot must occur between sunrise and sunset.
- The homeowner (lot owner) who is hosting the event must be present during the entire activity.
- 7. No one younger than 18 can be left unattended while the activity is taking place.
- 8. If watercraft is launched from the area, it must be registered and stickered to the host. No guest vessels are permitted.
