



Guidelines for Using the Picnic Shelter at Outlot A

The following list of guidelines will need to be followed when a homemaker wishes to use the shelter at Outlot A.

1. The homeowner (lot owner) must be in good standing with LAHA and have a key to open the gate.
2. A reservation date must be made with the LAHA President.
3. Any homeowner (lot owner) using the facility must take responsibility for setting up and cleaning up of the area that is used.
4. All garbage must be removed from the outlot at the end of the activity.
5. The following by-laws must be adhered to when using the shelter:
 - a. No vehicles can be parked in the outlot.
 - b. Alcohol is prohibited in the area as posted.
 - c. Use of the out lot must occur between sunrise and sunset.
6. The homeowner (lot owner) who is hosting the event must be present during the entire activity.
7. No one younger than 18 can be left unattended while the activity is taking place.
8. If watercraft is launched from the area, it must be registered and stickered to the host.
No guest vessels are permitted.
